

Cody A. Morris Memorial Skilled Trades Scholarship

Guidelines

PURPOSE

To assist deserving high school students in Queen Anne's County, Maryland pursue their goal of entering or continuing their training in a skilled trade.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicant must be a senior in good standing at a high school in Queen Anne's County who completes an application, submits a copy of their transcript, and describes which trade they are interested in pursuing and what type of assistance they will need to accomplish their goal.

AWARD AMOUNT

The number of scholarships awarded and the amount of the scholarships may vary from year to year.

SELECTION

Selection will be made by the Cody A. Morris Memorial Skilled Trades Scholarship selection committee with written notice prior to the award. The official award to the recipient will be announced in May. The scholarship is NOT renewable.

METHOD OF AWARD

The recipient will be required to provide Chesapeake Charities with specific information so that we can submit payment for training and/or supplies. Payment will be sent directly to cover the cost of tuition, testing or licensing fees, tools, safety gear, or related items upon verification of cost and appropriate billing from the school/vendor.

SUBMISSION
