Broadneck High School Application

Guidelines

PURPOSE

To assist deserving graduates of Broadneck High School in Anne Arundel County, Maryland to further their education at institutions of higher learning.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicant must be a senior in good standing at Broadneck High School who completes an application, provides one letter of recommendation, and submits an essay based on what makes them a responsible member of the community.

AWARD AMOUNT

The number of scholarships awarded and the amount of the scholarships may vary from year to year. For 2026 two scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each will be awarded to Broadneck High School students.

SELECTION

Selection will be made by the Julianne Rosela Memorial Scholarship selection committee with written notice prior to the award. The official award to the recipient will be announced in May. The scholarship is NOT renewable.

METHOD OF AWARD

The recipient will be required to notify Chesapeake Charities of his/her final school choice and the due date for payment. The money will be sent directly to the school upon verification of the student's enrollment and appropriate billing from the school.
